*Since statistics are reported weekly, the Broadway season of 52 weeks amounts to 364 days. Therefore, a week is added to the Broadway season every seven years.

Playing weeks represent the overall number of weeks of performance logged by all productions during the season. **Gross** represents the Gross Gross. **Attendance** represents paid and complimentary tickets. **% capacity** reflects the percentage of available seats filled (attendance / capacity). **Average paid admission** = total gross / total attendance. The **numbers of performances** include previews. **New productions** reflect productions that officially opened within that season.

¹ The 2019-20 season was cut short by the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic which led to a complete shutdown of Broadway in March 2020. The season tallies for the 2019-20 season reflect performances through the week ending March 8, 2020, the last full week of performances of that season. The 2021-22 season marked the return of Broadway. However, the start of the season was delayed by 10 weeks; re-openings were staggered; and there were numerous COVID-related cancellations of performances, including during the December/New Year's holidays.
